Waheeda inspires great empathy as she mentors and guards the younger courtesans because of her nurturing personality and moral clarity. Strong emotional ties are fostered by Lajjo's joyful disposition and close relationships, which offer harmony and comedic relief. Tajdar arouses a variety of emotions with his cunning and unclear motivations, propelling the story and character growth.

Because of these two distinct points of view – that of the audience and the director – the storytelling and viewing experience are improved, and *Heeramandi* becomes a more complex and emotionally compelling series.
